13:30	<p>Welcome and Opening Address <i>Seig de Vater, Founder, The Ton</i></p> <p>Seig has over 25 years of experience with Family Offices in the UK, starting with Cazenove & Co., where for 12 years he looked after Family Office funds and companies, and built relationships with over 200 families. In 2000, Seig founded de Brecks Advisory and has raised in excess of US\$6 billion for various investment strategies. In 2004, Seig founded a service to visit and meet with the family offices of Australia and the Super Funds (Pension Funds). In 2005, Seig also founded the European Family Office Investment Forum. In 2011, Seig was appointed Chairman of FMG Eurasia, which specialises in frontier funds, Iraq, MENA, Russia, China, India and Africa.</p>
13:40	<p>Presentation one 2016 – The Year of Opportunity for European Media and Tech <i>Jonathan Goodwin, Founder, Lepe Partners; Co-Founder, Founders Forum, ProFounders Capital</i></p> <p>Jonathan founded Lepe Partners in 2011, an independent merchant bank focused on the media, internet and consumer sectors. Lepe combines corporate finance advisory and principal investment practices dedicated to helping clients, portfolio companies and investors unlock growth. Jonathan was CEO/Co-Founder of LongAcre Partners, Europe's leading mid-market media corporate finance house, sold to Jefferies in 2007. He was Group MD of the Wireless Group Plc, a UK radio group, formed when he left Apex Partners to join a buyout of the radio station Talk Radio in 1997 with the backing of New Corporation and Liberty Media. In 2005, Jonathan created Founders Forum with Brent Hoberman. In 2009 they co-founded ProFounders Capital. Jonathan is President of the British Fashion Council Investment Pillar, Treasurer of Centre of Policy Studies and on the advisory board for the Tech City Future Fifty. He is also a member of the Board of the V&A and Chairman of the NSPCC Digital Taskforce.</p>
14:00	<p>Presentation Two 'Getting an Award is not the same as getting Paid' 30 years of funding and managing the enforcement and recovery of large claims <i>Wieger Wielinga, Partner</i></p> <p>Wieger is Managing Partner of Omni Bridgeway. He began his career in 1992 as an attorney at Loeff Claey Verbeke (now Allen & Overy), where he specialized in litigation and insolvency matters. He has extensive litigation and debt restructuring experience, including as court appointed receiver and advisor to the World Bank, the International Finance Corporation and international banks. He served in the Royal Dutch Army as an officer with the military intelligence service, where he received intensive Russian language training. Wieger holds an MBA from INSEAD, Fontainebleau, France, a Masters in Law from Leiden University and a post doctorate degree in Insolvency Law from the University of Nijmegen.</p> <p><i>Jurriaan Braat, Partner</i></p> <p>Jurriaan is a Partner with Omni Bridgeway, Geneva. Delia graduated in Jakarta in 1983 completing her undergraduate studies at NYU in 1987 and her Master's degree at SDSU in 1993.
