Major General (Ret 'd) J M Cowan CBE DSO Chief Executive Officer, The HALO Trust

James Cowan is CEO of The HALO Trust. HALO is the world's leading NGO clearing the debris of war with 12,500 staff in 30 countries and territories. At a time of unprecedented man-made humanitarian crisis, HALO's work has never been more important. James was a soldier for 30 years, serving in Germany, Northern Ireland, Africa, Hong Kong, Iraq and Afghanistan. He commanded his Regiment, The Black Watch, in Iraq in 2004 during fighting in Basra and subsequently around Fallujah. He was back in Iraq in 2006-07, again in Basra. He took command of Task Force Helmand and served in Afghanistan during 2009-10. He was subsequently Head of Counter Terrorism in the British MOD and led the planning for the 2012 Olympics military security operation. His last job in the British Army was as General Officer Commanding The 3rd (UK) Division. James left the Army in 2015 to become Chief Executive of The HALO Trust. He read Modern History at Oxford and took an M Phil at Cambridge and has a long-standing interest in military history and the Napoleonic Wars. He is married to Minnie with three children and lives in Dorset, UK.

Jeremy Fitton founded SkyLifter (www.skylifter.aero) after 30 years of C-level leadership, including taking German start-up Dedrone to \$28 million Silicon Valley funding and EU-wide market penetration in 24 months. In that time, Jeremy experienced the logistics bottlenecks faced by construction and primary industries and saw the solution in Lighter-than-Air technology. He then applied his business development expertise to develop solutions to the primary challenges that have held back its exploitation. SkyLifter now develops the IP of zero-emission precision heavy lifting with 2-250 tonne payload capacity, targeting a £10+ billion market opportunity across offshore wind, construction, logistics and defence sectors, with operations planned within 24 months.

This will be their new hook-in-the-sky that will out-perform any heavy-lift crane (with unlimited hook height and reach) and out-lift any helicopter or drone, and all for less cost, less drama, and no emissions. SkyLifter's IP comes from combining the proven technologies of aerostatic buoyancy with drone precision control. The new methods of control stability and concept of operations are being patented and the new omnidirectional capability will open the skies for a long list of customers needing off-road transit, heavy lift, and or extreme geo-stationary flight duration.</p>

QUADRI

Quadri Ventures is a Venture Capital fund with offices in New York and London, investing across the US and Europe. Co-founded and anchored by a single-family office, the firm focuses on Series A and B investments in enterprise software, with a particular emphasis on cloud, AI and intelligent infrastructure. Quadri partners with leading technology platforms, including Nvidia, Anthropic, and AWS, to gain market insights, enhance sourcing, and deliver value-add support to portfolio companies. With a presence in two global tech hubs and a strategy rooted in deep sector expertise, Quadri Ventures backs founders building the next generation of enterprise innovation.



Wiston Capital is a fund management company investing in crypto assets. The flagship fund is the Bitcoin & General Fund, which is an open-ended hedge fund providing investors with liquid, long-only exposure to a selection of digital assets. The aim is to outperform bitcoin and make strong long term capital gains for investors. Charlie Erith is the Fund Manager, and the research team comprises one full time and two consultant analysts. We also run a course, called Crypto Bootcamp, which gives investors an introductory understanding of crypto. These courses are held monthly in Pratts Club in Central London. Prospective investors in the asset class are strongly encouraged to attend this informative and highly enjoyable format. Wiston Capital is based in the UK. Charlie Erith is approved by the FCA in his role as manager of the Bitcoin & General Fund.



Hiizzy is the UK's first pure consumer-to-consumer property marketplace—an entirely new model in an industry long overdue for change. By removing estate agents and replacing them with elegant technology, Hiizzy enables homeowners to list, manage, and sell their properties directly—without commissions, without intermediaries, and without compromise. This is not a cheaper estate agent. It is an entirely different category. Estate agency in the UK is inefficient, expensive, and opaque. Despite rapid advancements in fintech, open data and AI, the process of selling a home remains difficult and slow, costing consumers £14 billion annually in fees and absorbing unnecessary time and effort. There has never been a more opportune moment to disintermediate this model. Hiizzy targets the UK residential sales sector, a £14B fee-based market, with expansion potential into lettings, financial services, and international territories. The growth path mirrors the disruption seen in wealth management, payments, and insurance: tech-led, consumer-driven, and margin-shifting.



Two Daughters Entertainment Ltd, founded by James Reatchlous in 2016, is a British animation studio celebrated for creating high-quality content for children, young adults, and families. Its flagship series, Moley, has aired in over 180 countries and features a standout voice cast including Warwick Davis and Gemma Arterton. In February 2025, the company secured a major distribution deal to bring Moley to China via leading streaming platforms iQiyi and Youku. Two Daughters has now also produced its first feature film, The Land of Sometimes, a magical musical adventure set in a whimsical world of imagination, the company's first full animated feature. This project builds on the studio's creative legacy as it continues developing a feature-length animated film to expand its global reach and inspire audiences worldwide.

A further special limited edition of busts in both sizes will be available as "The Blenheim Edition". These casts will be mounted on Cotswold Lime Stone sourced from the stone of which Blenheim Palace is constructed. Each edition is strictly limited and can also be inscribed with Churchill's name and dates.



About the Artist

A passion for art and a strongly creative nature has underscored Tristram Lewis's life. After varied careers as a house builder, commercial fisherman, fish trader, and commodity broker when he became a full time artist at fifty.

Sculpture quickly became his chosen medium, where he developed a traditional style enriched by the use of modern techniques. His inspiration is often drawn from his love of horses, wildlife, military and historical subjects.
